

Bangor University Students' Union Constitution: Part 2 – By-Laws

By-Law 15 – Undeb Bangor Policy

This Bye-Law is the property of the Trustee Board and can be amended by the Trustee Board, Undeb Bangor Council and the Undeb Bangor Student Members Meetings, in line with their procedures.

1 Setting and Passing Policy

- 1.1 Policy of the students' Union can be set and passed by;
 - 1.1.1 Undeb Bangor Council (in accordance with Bye-Law 6 – Undeb Bangor Council),
 - 1.1.2 General Meeting (in accordance with Bye-Law 4).
 - 1.1.3 Referendum (in accordance with Bye-Law 3 – Referenda)
- 1.2 Policy can not contradict the laws of the land or the values of the Students' Union.

2 Passed Policy

- 2.1 Passed policy will last for the remainder of the academic year in which it is agreed and for one complete academic year following this, unless;
 - 2.1.1 It is resolved.
 - 2.1.2 It is overturned by a higher body or referendum in accordance with 4.1
 - 2.1.3 It is reaffirmed in accordance with 3.
- 2.2 The Chair and Secretary of Undeb Bangor Council will maintain an online Policy record and will ensure any changes are updated within 10 working days.

3 Reaffirming Policy

- 3.1 Policies can be reaffirmed in the first Undeb Bangor Council of the academic year for which they are up for renewal.
- 3.2 Policies which are not reaffirmed in the first Undeb Bangor Council of the academic year for which they are up for renewal will lapse.

4 Overturning Policy

- 4.1 Policy may be overturned by a higher body and may only be attempted to be overturned once in an academic year.
- 4.2 For clarity the hierarchy of bodies, from highest to lowest are;
 - 4.2.1 Referendum
 - 4.2.2 Student Members Meeting
 - 4.2.3 Undeb Bangor Council
- 4.3 A referendum can overturn a referendum, but not in the same academic year.
